As some have speculated, certain people and people groups would like to see Christian radio content be strictly regulated by the government. Some even would prefer that Christian radio stations operating on FCC issued licenses would actually be shut down, due to what is now commonly known as "hate speech". This may be coming our way if things continue to progress culturally as anti-Christian.

Though we know of no valid organized effort to regulate or remove Christian radio per say, it is highly probable that the day will come when Christian broadcasters will face either compromising the teaching of God's Word, or losing quardianship of a radio license.

The Mars Hill Network can proudly say that we are an accredited member of National Religious Broadcasters Association (NRB). NRB looks after the welfare of the Christian broadcasting industry in the United States. They offer numerous resources to each affiliated station, and monitor current FCC regulations, as well as music industry regulations that may greatly affect Christian radio They offer legal representation regarding issues that may threaten the future of the Christian broadcaster's First Amendment rights.

Our ongoing membership with NRB is just one of the many ways your contribution to the Mars Hill Network is used. Our affiliation with NRB helps to ensure that our First Amendment rights will not be inhibited.


Airing weekday mornings at 8:30 AM, a short feature from The Colson Center hosted by


Now, Face to Face...a Studio Upgrade

We're thankful for God's provision to upgrade our Production Room #1, we at Mars Hill call it, "Prod.1".

Prod.1 was last updated in the early 1980's. At that time we were still using turntables and tape machines for our primary production means. Times change, and with that change came digital audio. Turntables were replaced by CD players, mini-disks, DAT tapes, and finally digital computer storage and "flash/thumb drives". New production studios are simply hard audio boards, mics and computers, with audio boards most likely disappearing in favor of virtual audio boards in the near future.

How blessed Mars Hill Network is to have a skilled, in-house engineer as a full time staff member. Mike Dwinell not only maintains all of our radio outlets throughout the state, but works with IT issues as well. Mike's expertise in studio design allowed us to upgrade our main Control Room a few years ago, and those skills greatly facilitated our Prod. 1 upgrade. Along with a seasoned tradesman, and help from our part time maintenance person, Mike was able to see his blueprints come to life.

Prod.1 boasts a comfortable studio setting with lots of versatility. Face to face interviews are made so much simpler, something that our old production studio was not designed for. Grateful we are to be able to utilize the gifts God has provided through many of our radio partners, helping to produce a better audio product...all to the glory of God.

Saluting a New Kid's Ministry

Keeping Kids Connected is a grass roots children's ministry that keeps military kids connected with their enlisted parent(s) or caregivers in a fun and effective way.

Mitchell Aquirre, a New York City businessman residing in Queens, was inspired to create this unique ministry that utilizes colorful personalized printed material and online interactive exercises with the goal of staying connected with their parent(s) who often are called away for military duty. or keep ever-changing varied service hours. Children of the military often are in a transient lifestyle, being uprooted from their familiar surroundings, those surroundings that bring a sense of stability to their lives. Mitchell credits his idea to time spent away from his own son while doing a stint in prison for a bad business deal. Mitchell would create stories with hand drawn pictures and mail them to his son as a way to keep a close connection.

Keeping Kids Connected purposely offers children an opportunity to "belong" to a spiritually meaningful, interactive, fun and caring evangelistic ministry, one that clearly proclaims Jesus Christ and God's plan of salvation.

Kids are invited to create a personalized Christian-themed story book online, then receive that quality printed book in the mail. The children submit names of their loved ones, and are able to select people features that may closely resemble family members. This personalization becomes resident in every published story. Each month a new story is sent to those enrolled in the ministry, and is able to be placed in the sturdy storybook cover binder, adding new chapters on a regular basis.

Other activities are routinely featured online, all designed to help the child keep connected with their "away" parent or caregiver.

The Mars Hill Network, as a media partner, hopes to encourage local churches and ministries, especially in the Fort Drum listening area, to adopt **Keeping Kids Connected** as a part of their mission to military families.
